The Board has the responsibility for selecting and evaluating the President/Chief Executive Officer (CEO). The Board delegates full responsibility and authority to him or her to implement and administer Board policies without Board interference and holds him or her accountable for the leadership and operation of the CHPA.

The President/CEO shall take direction from the Board members only when sitting in a duly held meeting of the Board. No individual Board member shall give any direction or instructions to the President/CEO. However, the provisions of this policy shall not be construed to prevent any Board member from discussing matters of CHPA with the President/CEO.

Neither the Board nor any of its members shall give direction or instructions to any subordinate of the President/CEO. Behavior inconsistent with this policy would be considered a violation of Board Code of Conduct.
