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Status	In Development
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The President/Chief Executive Officer or designee has the authority to enter into contracts for goods and services or other activities within the mission of the school, provided the amount involved does not exceed \$50,000 and is within the adopted budget. In order to receive the greatest value for each dollar expended, it shall be the policy of the school to obtain comparative prices based on similar quality, to consider a balance between long-term quality and cost, and to purchase in quantity whenever possible and practical.

Chavez/Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy (CHPA) will establish a list of preferred vendors to utilize in the procurement process for services, supplies and other activities. Preferred Vendors deliver the best overall value to CHPA based on the price, delivery capabilities, quality, past performance, training, financial stability, ease of ordering, etc.
