Any sexual assault or physical abuse, including, but not limited to, rape, as defined by Colorado law, whether committed by an employee, student, or member of the public that occurs on Chavez/Huerta K-12 Preparatory Academy property or school sponsored function is a violation of policies and procedures, and is subject to all applicable punishment, including criminal procedures and employee or student discipline procedures. Students, faculty, and staff who may be victims of sexual and other assaults shall be treated with dignity and provided comprehensive assistance. The President/Chief Executive Officer with building level Principals shall establish administrative procedures that ensure that students, faculty, and staff who are victims of sexual and other assaults receive appropriate information regarding treatment and that educational information about preventing sexual violence is provided and publicized as required by law.
