Employees and students who use CHPA computer networks and other technology, and the information they contain, and related resources have the responsibility not to abuse the resources and to respect the rights of others.

The President/Chief Executive Officer shall establish procedures that provide guidelines to students and staff for the appropriate use of information technologies. The procedures shall include that users must respect software copyrights and licenses, respect the integrity of computer-based information resources, refrain from seeking to gain unauthorized access, and respect the rights of other computer users.

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
