The President/Chief Executive Officer shall assure that, as required by law, reports are prepared of all occurrences reported to the school security office in collaboration with school Principals of any arrest for crimes committed on campus that involve violence, hate violence, theft or destruction of property, illegal drugs, or alcohol intoxication. The President/Chief Executive Officer or Designee shall further assure that required reports of non-criminal acts are prepared. Such reports shall be made available as required by law and shared with the Board annually.
