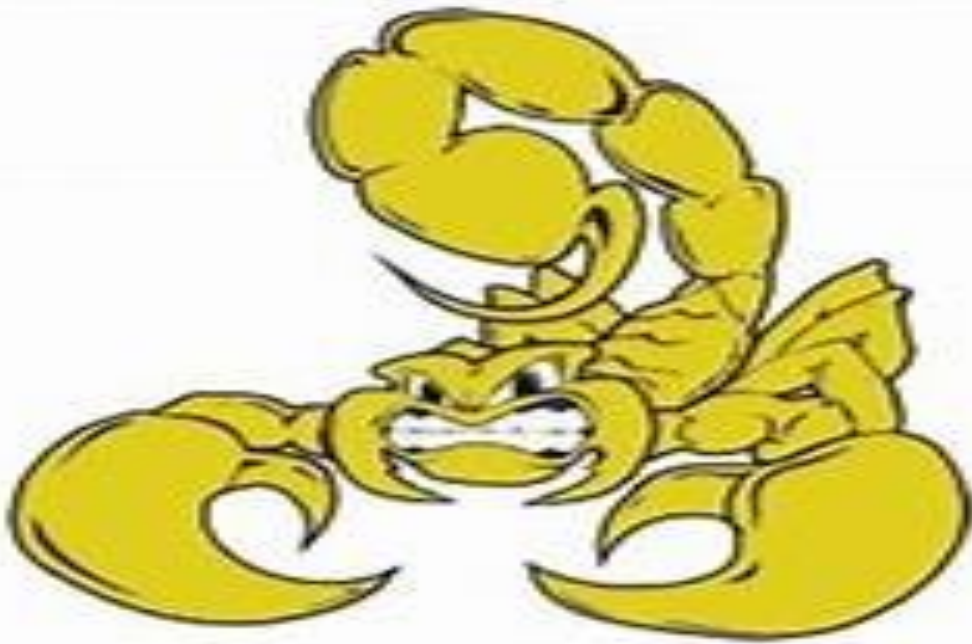
Trypohbia is an aversion or repulsion to objects like honeycombs and sponges that have repetitive patterns or clusters of small holes.
